# Brian Crowell wins his first Pro Series Event at Pilgrim Lanes

This first event was a Singles Elimination, which is slightly different from our previous singles events. After a five string qualifying round, the top 32 move on to the elimination round. In the elimination round, the top 32 bowl 1 string, with the top 16 scores moving on. Instead of bowling head-to-head matches, bowlers put up their best score with the top 16 scores (and ties) moving on. In the second round the top 8 scores and ties move on, and this continues until the final round.

Brian Crowell became the first champion of the season as he won the Singles Elimination, giving him his first Pro Series title. He did so in dramatic fashion defeating Shawn Baker in the finals, 130-124. Brian qualified tied for 5<sup>th</sup> with Shawn Morrison with a score of 679, including a 171 middle string.

In the qualifying round, Brian Crowell was simply untouchable. He rolled consecutive strings of 143, 137, 166, 147 and 130 for a 5 string elimination round total of 723! If you add his qualifying total to his elimination round total, Brian bowled a ten string total of 1402, to average 140 for the tournament. Brian earned 135 points in the qualifying round and 300 points in the elimination round to put him in first place in the points standings after 1 event.

After bowling two strings of 143 and 137, Brian opened the third string of the elimination with 7 marks in a row, and finished with two marks in the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> frames to finish with a 166. Brian then cruised to the final match with a score of 147, setting up a matchup with Shawn Baker. Brian started the final string by hitting the head pin and leaving 5-6-7-10 without wood. He put the 6-10 off the wall and it came right back to take out the 5 and the 7 pins to send the crowd into frenzy. What a way to start out the string! Filling it with seven turned out to be key since he won the string by six (130-124).

#### **A Look Ahead: Doubles Knockout**

Join us this Sunday, September 19, 2011 in Portsmouth at the Bowlarama for the first Doubles Knockout of the season. Members and non-members alike will team up and bowl a five string qualifying round with the top 24 teams making the knockout round, and the top 8 receiving the bye. All are welcome to Portsmouth, NH to witness some of the best bowlers in the New England Area. The qualifying rounds begin at 10, and the ladder rounds should begin around 4 PM.
